



### **BACKGROUND**

The Board is looking to evaluate the impact that active Intent-to-Serve ("ITS") water commitments may impose on the District's water supply if all ITS applications matured to Will-Serve commitments.

At your Board's December 14, 2016 Board Meeting, the 1<sup>st</sup> status report of active ITS letters was presented by the General Manager. The Board had given staff direction to provide a compilation of actions including presentations and reports, so the Board can take the appropriate actions needed to protect the groundwater basin, meet basin management pumping requirements while recognizing District commitments to applicants who have an economic investment in their projects.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> of two status report presentations, this presentation intends to answer questions generated by the Board from the 1<sup>st</sup> status report presentation. Follow-up information requested by the Board included providing a 6-month total groundwater pumping update and additional information on fees paid to NCSD by ITS applicants.
