Fix a Leak Week



Save water, save money!

Check your sprinklers in the spring, summer and fall.
Turn on the valve and look for:

Symptoms of Poor Maintenance:

1

- Erosion
- Water runoff and swampy areas
- Obstructions of spray
- Plants performing poorly
- Water spraying on the street or sidewalk

Problems with Sprinkler Heads and Valves:

2

- Head clogged, leaking, or broken
- Valve leaking
- Plants blocking sprinkler
- Head pushed too far into the ground or spraying in the wrong direction
- Sprinkler spacing not providing even coverage on turf grass

3

Low Water Pressure:

- Popup stem not extending
- Spray not reaching intended watering area
- Doughnut shaped dry areas in turf

4

High Water Pressure:

- Pipe keeps breaking
- Sprinkler nozzles blown off
- Spray is misting or fogging or spray is overshooting desired area
