



Save water, save mone

Check your sprinklers in the spring, summer and fall. Turn on the valve and look for:

Symptoms of Poor Maintenance:

- Erosion
- Water runoff and swampy areas
- Obstructions of spray
- Plants performing poorly
- Water spraying on the street or sidewalk

Problems with Sprinkler Heads and Valves:

- Head clogged, leaking, or broken
- Valve leaking
- Plants blocking sprinkler
- · Head pushed too far into the ground or spraying in the wrong direction
- Sprinkler spacing not providing even coverage on turf grass

Low Water Pressure:

- Popup stem not extending
- Spray not reaching intended watering area
- Doughnut shaped dry areas in turf

High Water Pressure:

- Pipe keeps breaking
- Sprinkler nozzles blown off
- Spray is misting or fogging or spray is overshooting desired area
