NCSD 2015 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) Scheduled for Adoption

At its May 25th Regular Meeting, the District's Board of Directors heard a presentation of the draft Plan and held a Public Hearing. The Board scheduled the Plan for adoption at its June 8, 2016 Regular meeting.

In April, the District held an agency coordination workshop and, on May 11, the Board directed staff to circulate the Public Review Draft 2015 UWMP dated May 2016 to the County, interested parties and the public for comment. Notice of the May 25, 2016 public hearing to consider comments on the Public Review Draft 2015 UWMP was published in the Santa Maria Times and the San Luis Obispo Tribune.

UWMPs are prepared by California's urban water suppliers to support their long-term resource planning, and ensure adequate water supplies are available to meet existing and future water demands.

The Nipomo CSD enlisted the professional engineering services of Michael K. Nunley (MKN) & Associates, Inc. and partnered with local agencies to prepare the Plan. Preparation of the Plan included analysis of projected population growth, current and future water demands, as well as water supply and pumping data.

Once the final UWMP is adopted and submitted to the Department of Water Resources (DWR), a public copy will be available for review at the District office and on the District website.
