**Nipomo CSD Receives “Clean Opinion” for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Financial Audit Report**

At its November 8<sup>th</sup> Regular meeting, the District’s Board of Directors accepted the District’s financial Audit Report for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 and directed staff to file the Report.

Rogers, Anderson, Malody & Scott, LLP (RAMS), conducted the annual audit and presented the report to the Board. The District is required by law to have an independent audit performed annually on its financial statements.

The District once again received an unqualified (or “clean”) opinion on its Report and will be submitting the Report to the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for review and consideration for the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting.

The District’s audit report received this prestigious recognition of accounting excellence the past four consecutive years.

General Manager, Mario Iglesias, stated “The District’s financial fitness must be maintained to the highest levels in these uncertain times. Thanks to the community’s support, the Board of Directors’ oversight and a team of professionals dedicated to customer service, NCS D is positioned financially to ensure the future water needs of Nipomo are met.”
