## SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NIPOMO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING NIPOMO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT CODE CHAPTER 3.24

On December 12, 2018, the Board of Directors of the Nipomo Community Services District ("District") introduced on first reading an ordinance amending Nipomo Community Services District Code ("District Code") Chapter 3.24 ("Ordinance").

The Ordinance will amend District Code Chapter 3.24 to incorporate Water Conservation Requirements that were previously adopted via Resolution as part of the District's Water Shortage Response and Management Plan into an ordinance pursuant to Water Code sections 375, et seq., and 71640, et seq. Under the proposed Ordinance, the District's Board of Directors may order its customers, by Resolution, to implement certain conservation measures during times of drought, to address threatened or existing water shortages, or to respond to potentially severe or severe water shortage conditions as identified by the Nipomo Mesa Management Area Technical Group, which was established as part of the Santa Maria Groundwater Litigation. The proposed Ordinance provides that violations of any ordered conservation requirements may be enforced pursuant to District Code section 3.04.370 and that such remedies are in addition to any other remedies available to the District by law.

The first reading and introduction of the Ordinance occurred on December 12, 2018. Second reading and adoption of the Ordinance is scheduled for the January 9, 2019, regular Board of Directors meeting.
