Blacklake Sewer System Consolidation:

You may have noticed the ongoing construction activity at our Blacklake Wastewater Treatment Plant near the NW corner of Willow and Sundale. We are still on track to “flip the switch” — the lift station is estimated to be completed around July 2025. Look out for an upcoming "Flip the Switch" ceremony!

Blacklake Street Lights

District staff is continuing to work towards improving our response to the street lights that are out in the Blacklake neighborhood. Thank you for your patience as we work through the challenges. In view of a permanent fix, we intend to convert the remaining streetlights to LED, which are more energy efficient. We hope to complete this effort by the end of this year.

- ...# New 1-Million Gallon Water Storage Tank at Foothill Tank Site
- ...# Update the District’s Strategic Plan
- ...# Wastewater Rates Prop 218

High Efficiency Washing Machine Rebate

As a District customer and homeowner, you may be eligible for a \$75 rebate on a new high-efficiency washing machine! Old washing machines account for about 20% of indoor water use— up to 60 gallons per load of wash! High-efficiency washers use up to 50% less water and energy, and 2/3 less detergent. Most are also large enough to wash bulky items like quilts, pillows and sleeping bags.
