BACKGROUND

On December 11, 2019, the Board awarded a construction contract for the Southland WWTF Storage Building Project to PWS Construction Inc. The work involved the construction of a 1,440 square foot metal building that will be used to store spare parts for the Southland WWTF and an integral 960 square foot lean-to that will provide a covered storage area for equipment utilized at the Southland WWTF. Construction has been completed.
