Projects in Progress

- Frontage Road Trunk Sewer Replacement Phase 1 – upgrade from 15" to 18" diameter gravity sewer main on Frontage Road between Juniper St. and Division St. – *currently in progress; completion in July 2026*
- New 1-Million Gallon Water Storage Tank at Foothill Tank Site – *Fall 2026*
- Update the District Strategic Plan – *in progress*
- Meter change out program to Advance Metering Infrastructure (AMI) - *Ongoing*
- Blacklake sewer consolidation project – *currently in progress; completion in August 2026*
- Woodgreen Lift Station Project – *currently in progress; completion in July 2026*

Extra Garbage Services

Don't forget to use your two complementary annual bulk pickup vouchers! These vouchers take the place of Clean-Up week, with one voucher to be used from January to June, and the other to be used July through December. And don't worry if you don't have a voucher in hand. Please call South County Sanitary Services ("Garbage Company") at (805) 489-4246 to schedule your pickup.

Each voucher provides for an additional (6) - 32 gallon trash bags, and 1 bulky item on your trash day. Also, remember household hazardous waste materials like paint and motor oil, and e-waste, like a microwave or printer, can be properly disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Facility located at 509 Southland St. in Nipomo on Saturdays, from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm. The NCS D Garbage Voucher Program is Easy to Use!

1. Call the Garbage Company, up to two (2) times per calendar year, to let them know you'd like to use your voucher to schedule a "bulky item" pickup.
2. The Garbage Company will take your request and explain the voucher. They will handle the tracking of each residents account and usage so all you have to do is call.
